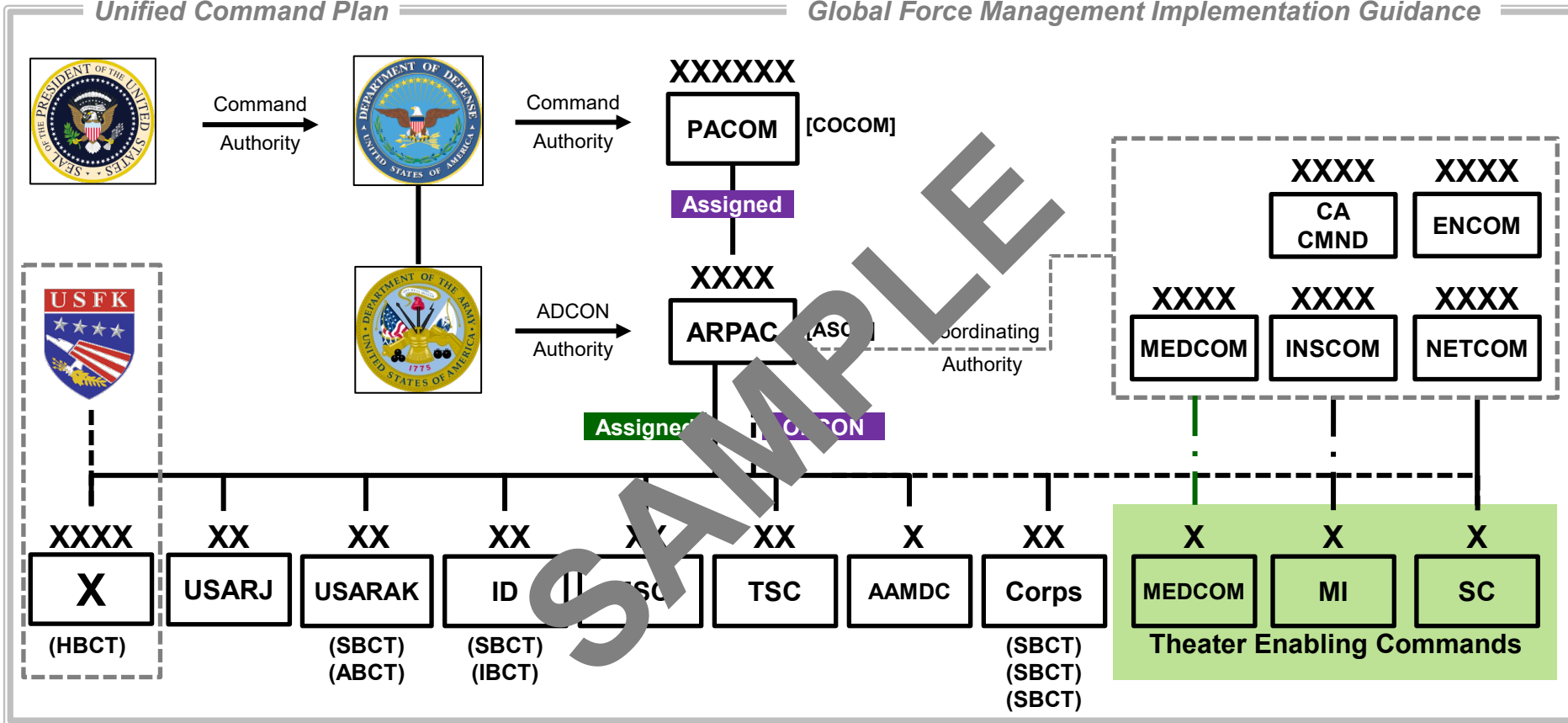


Army C2 in the PACIFIC

Global Force Management Implementation Guidance

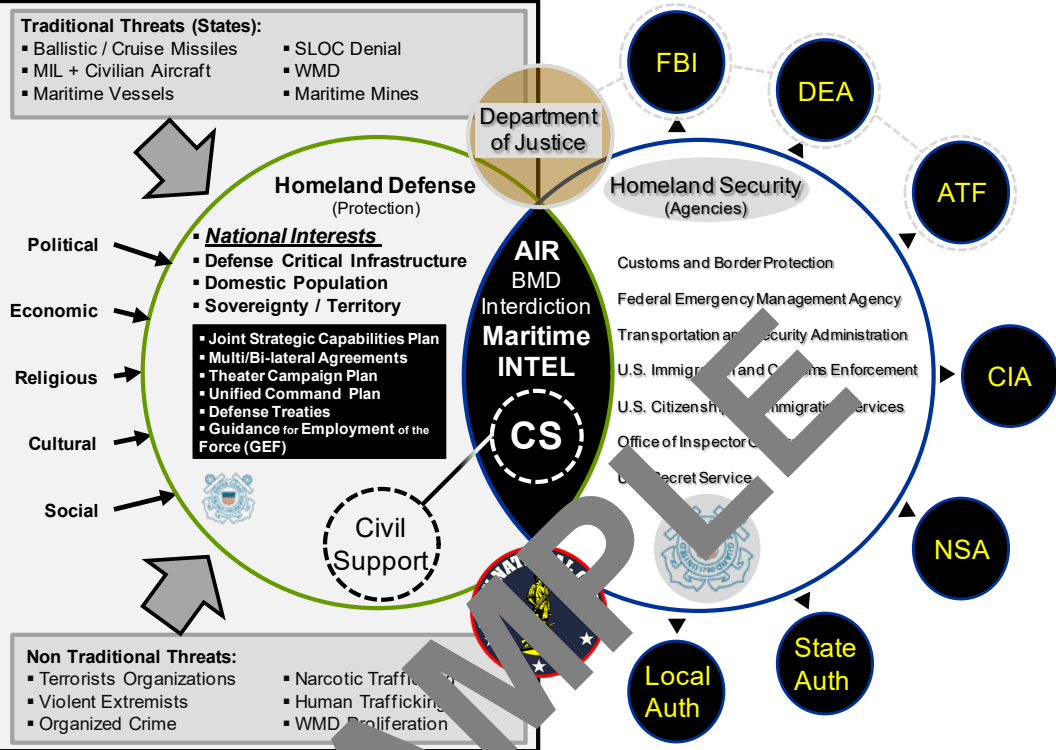

	All Army forces are OPCON to ASCC for Command Authority
Theater Enabling Command (TEC): Centralized C2 of Enabling Functions (e.g. LOG, ENG) IOT ensure theater-wide coverage/support

FIRST RESPONDERS

- **CST** (NG Civil SPT TM): Assess suspected WMD ATKs, advise civilian responders, facilitate arrival additional state + FED MIL FRCs | 24-7 stand-by, advance team capable of deploying w/in 90 minutes, main body w/in 3 hrs
- **CERPPF** (CBRNE Enhanced Response FRC PKG): Immediate response capability to Governor | incident site search - damaged buildings, rescue trapped casualties, provide decontamination, medical triage, + initial treatment - stabilize patients
- **NGRF** (NG Reaction FRCs): 50-75 PAX w/in 4-48 hrs + Up to 400 PAX w/in 24-36 hrs | state assets operationally falling under C2 of the State Adjutant General | MSNs include but not limited too: site security, presence patrols + show of force, establishing road blocks + checkpoints, controlling civil disturbances, DoD CIP

Homeland Defense is the protection of US sovereignty, territory, domestic population, and critical defense infrastructure against external threats and aggression, or other threats as directed by the President. DOD is responsible for the HD mission, and therefore leads the HD response, with other departments and agencies in support of DOD efforts ... Defense of the homeland is the DOD's highest priority **with the goal to defeat threats at a safe distance from the homeland.** (JP3-27)

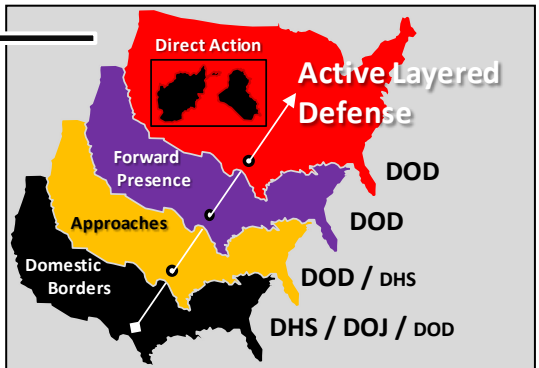
