




National Guard Capabilities

■ CST (NG Civil SPT TM): Assess suspected WMD ATKs, advise civilian responders, facilitate arrival additional state + FED MIL FRCs | 24-7 stand-by, advance team capable of deploying w/in 90 minutes, main body w/in 3 hrs ■ CERPFP (CBRNE Enhanced Response FRC PKG): Immediate response capability to Governor | incident site search - damaged buildings, rescue trapped

L casualties, provide decontamination, medical triage, + initial treatment - stabilize patients ■ **NGRF** (NG Reaction FRCs):
